

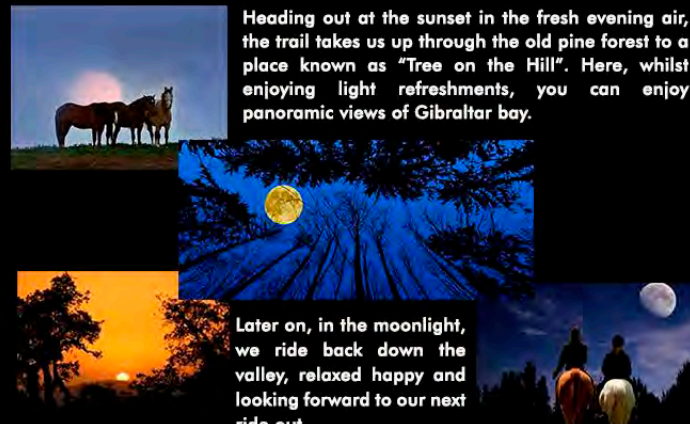
1. "Finca Alcaidesa" the forest hack



Nature at its best five minutes away from Sotogrande and the coast (5 km). This Natural Park is one of the area's best-kept secrets. It has an impressive surface area of 1.500 hectares with wild olive trees, cork oaks and pines. For those who love

nature riding here is a unique experience. A habitat shared with mountain goats, deer, wild boar, foxes and stunning bird life.

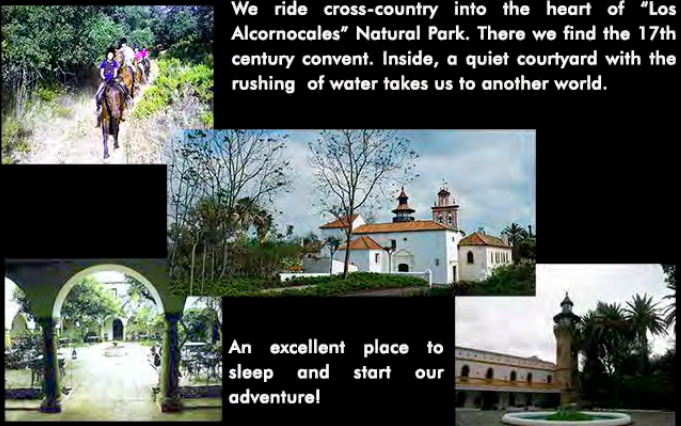
2. Moonlight ride



Heading out at the sunset in the fresh evening air, the trail takes us up through the old pine forest to a place known as "Tree on the Hill". Here, whilst enjoying light refreshments, you can enjoy panoramic views of Gibraltar bay.

Later on, in the moonlight, we ride back down the valley, relaxed happy and looking forward to our next ride out.

3. Convento de la Almoraima



We ride cross-country into the heart of "Los Alcornocales" Natural Park. There we find the 17th century convent. Inside, a quiet courtyard with the rushing of water takes us to another world.

An excellent place to sleep and start our adventure!

4. The anthropomorphic tombs



As in the ancient time, we will ride on horseback to discover the hidden path to the caves where, from prehistoric times, men were protected from bad weather and wars. If we are lucky, we also find the way to the anthropomorphic tombs.

An exciting trail full of history and adventure!

5. Pinar del Rey



In the year 1800 the Spanish Navy created this park to grow pine trees to build their ships. After the battle of Trafalgar they stopped using the wood of this forest. The riding is truly spectacular!

Along sandy tracks, perfect for long canters under the shady ancient pine trees

6. Sierra del Arca



on this hack we ride out from our stables, we go to the "Sierra del Arca", a seven hundred meter high "table" mountain with stunning views over the bay of Algeciras, Gibraltar Rock, the Mediterranean sea and Sotogrande.

On days when a Western wind blows, you can reach out and almost touch Morocco.

7. The Beach Hack



Hacks on the unspoilt Guadalquivir beach with views of the Strait of Gibraltar and Africa. The Guadalquivir cork oak tree woods are the last remaining Mediterranean eco-systems of its kind by the coast. Riding on the beach is a unique experience

The Gateway to the Mediterranean as a backdrop will make it unforgettable.

8. The prairie



Right next to our park is a vast grassland where horses and cattle are grazing quietly. It is an amazing opportunity for exhilarating canters, experiencing total freedom in the saddle, combined with the beauty of nature. Every season the colours change,

the flowers abound and the contrasts in the landscape are unbelievable with its special light.

Things to know

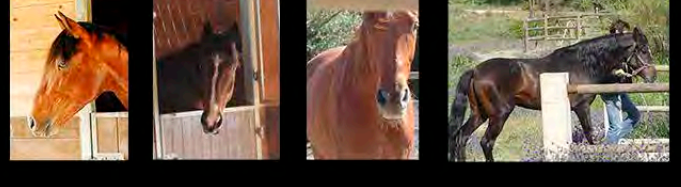
